Living a new life in Christ

*From the desk of Dereck...*

### Modern Day Good Samaritans - Luke 10:25-37

Jesus' parable of the Good Samaritan is the ultimate illustration of *"love your neighbour as yourself"*, the second greatest commandment of all. (Mark 12:31) We like to think of ourselves as modern-day good Samaritans, who are willing to reach out to neighbours who are in need. Jesus tells of a traveller who was robbed, stripped, beaten and left half dead. Two religious men came by but refused to help. Along comes a Samaritan who stops to offer aid. From this point, have we ever looked closely at what the Samaritan man did for the stranger, considering the risks and sacrifices that he made?

- **"When he saw him, he had compassion."** The Samaritan was moved to action by this powerful emotion. We often feel compassion for the less fortunate, but does that compassion compel us to stop whatever we're doing or go somewhere to do something about it?
- **"He went to him and bandaged his wounds."** This was a risky situation. It could have been a trap. Would we stop in a bad part of town, leaving ourselves vulnerable to attack? Would we render aid to a naked and bleeding man lying in the street?
- **"Pouring on oil and wine."** This may have been the traveller's only supplies. If he were a merchant, he would be losing income. If the injured person were dirty, bloody, or smelly, would we offer to touch him and risk soiling our own clothes to help him?
- **"He set him on his own animal."** Would we place this dirty, naked, and bloody person in our nice car that we spent R200 to have cleaned and detailed?
- **"He brought him to an inn and took care of him."** Would we take him to the nearest hospital Emergency room and sit with him until he was treated? What if we had an important appointment or social engagement?
- **"He took out two denarii and gave them to the innkeeper."** The denarii was a day's wage. The average South African minimum daily wage is R500. Would we spend over R500 on a two-night hotel stay for a stranger?
- **"Whatever more you spend, I will repay you."** What if the injured stranger needs to stay in the hotel for a month to recover? The average cost for a budget hotel is R500 per night. Would we be willing to pay over R15,000 to cover the expenses? You may say that this is all impractical, but it's exactly what the Good Samaritan did. If we want to be modern-day Samaritans, we must heed Jesus' words: **"Go and do likewise."**

Let us, as God's chosen vessels, live in such a way as to emulate the very essence of our Lord this week.
